

Land Patent Grant to Arthur McCabe in Sussex County

*June 9*—This day the Governor signed the following patents for Lands in Sussex County, which patents were presented for his signature by John Stockley, recorder of deeds for Sussex County—viz. One in favor of Arthur McCabe for 37 1/4 acres called "Song Lot." One in favor of Philip W. Mariner for 74 1/2 acres called "Partnership." One in favor of Nathaniel Ross for 26 3/4 acres called "Plane Dealing." One in favor of Benj. Hudson for 48 3/4 acres called "Hudson Improvement." One in favor of Robert Burton for 60 3/4 acres called "Addition to Robert," "Burtons Forrest Lands." One in favor of Caleb Ross & Thos. Rider 59 1/4 acres called "Double Purchase." One in favor of John Banning for 51 1/2 acres called "Banning's Venture." One in favor of Joseph Hudson for 145 1/2 acres called "Hudson's Regulation."
