

In the Name of God Amen: I James Murray of Sussex County, State of Delaware being of sound disposing mind and memory and understanding Thanks be to God therefore calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me, I do give bequeath and dispose of the same in the following manner and form to wit: I do give and bequeath unto my son Richard Murray my plantation by the name of Daniels place and one Bed and Furniture, on his paying his two Brothers Sovereign Murray and David Murray fifty Dollars a piece, to him and his heirs forever in

142/ case of no issue lawfully begotten of his body to my son Sovereign Murray. I do give and bequeath unto my son Milborn Murray the manner plantation where I now live by the name of Addition, one horse kind, one Cow, one Bed & furniture to him and his heirs forever, in case of no issue lawfully begotten of his body, to my son Elisha Murray on paying his two Brothers Elisha Murray and Isaac Murray fifty Dollars a piece. I do give and bequeath unto my son Milborn Murray a right to have log timber and fire wood off of the plantation I have before mentioned to my son Richard Murray so long as it shall not become injurious to the said Richard Murrays plantation. I do give and bequeath unto my daughter Nelly Murray a Heifer, one Bed and furniture & one Chest to her and her heirs forever. I do give and bequeath all the remaining part of my Estate after my just debts are paid unto five of my Children that is to say Sovereign Murray Nelly Murray, David Murray, Elisha Murray, Isaac Murray, to be equally divided, share and share about. Lastly I do nominate and appoint my son Elisha Murray Executor of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby revoke all other Heretofore by me made, ratifying and confirming this as my last Will and Testament, In Writings whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Sixth day of March Anno Domini 1813.

Sussex County, Md. Memorandum the 12<sup>th</sup> April 1819 before me Phillips Killeck Register appointed for the probate of Wills and granting Letters of Administration for the County aforesaid personally appeared John Long and Eber Long two of the subscribing Witnesses to the within and foregoing Will who have duly sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God did severally depose and say that in their sight, presence and hearing the testator James Murray did sign, Seal, publish, pronounce and declare the same to be his last Will and Testament and that at the doing thereof he seemed to be of a sound disposing mind memory and judgment and that they and each of them together with Joseph Long, severally subscribed the same as Witneses in presence of the said Testator and at his Request.
