Fares Include: All meals (except Chops & Portifinos specialty restaurants, Johnny Rockets has a \$4.95/pp cover charge), 24 hour room service (late night service charge of \$3.50 applies), nightly musical production shows, comic and musical shows, most beverages, ice skating, rock wall climbing, surfing, class golf tournament, class private slot tournament (entrance fee), group seating in the dining room, promenade parades and parties, use of all pools and hot tubs, pool lounge chairs, use of the gym, food at Sorrento's Pizza and Café Promenade (open 24 hours), production ice show, movies, deck parties and buffet.

All cabins have keypad operated safes, hair dryers, Wi-Fi internet access (for a fee), mini-fridges, flat-screen TV with a wide range of channels and interactive programming to order room service, shore excursions or check you onboard ship account and cabin controlled air conditioning. Bathrooms have showers with sliding doors and shampoo dispensers. All cabins feature Royal Caribbean's upgraded bedding with pillows, shams and duvets. Rooms can be set up with two twin beds or one queen bed, some cabins have a sofa bed and/or Pullman bed. Royal Caribbean uses a "cashless" system on board, your "sea pass card" is used to charge all ship board purchases and is your cabin door key and is used to identify you when you get off and on the ship.

There are two formal nights where gentlemen are asked to wear a suit, jacket and tie or tuxedo (can be rented on the ship) and ladies are asked to wear cocktail dresses or dressy pants suits. All other evenings are casual dress, slacks and shirt for the gentlemen and dresses or slacks for the ladies. Jean and shorts are request not to be worn in the Main Dining room in the evening. Around the ship it is casual but no bathing suits are allowed in the restaurants. One night is Caribbean Night with a deck party and mid-night buffet.

Each cabin will receive a **\$100 shipboard credit** toward all purchases on the ship. You will also get a Royal Caribbean Coupon book worth \$300 in shipboard match purchase items.
