The 19,000 American women listed in this volume were deemed "outstanding" in their professions and in their contributions to society.

Published by Marquis-Who's Who Incorporated, publishers of the very popular "Who's Who in America," a book giving information about the outstanding American people, the volume was partially compiled by the Women's Archives of Radcliffe College. An advisory group composed of influential and very capable representatives of the professions, social organizations, church and welfare organizations also assisted in choosing these fortunate 19,000 from the 50,000 women considered eligible for the honor.

Miss Swain, although born in New York State, has lived in Florida for 17 years. She taught at Hialeah Junior High School before coming to Hialeah Senior High when it was but a fledgling junior-senior high school.

Her education was obtained at the University of Miami, from which she earned a Bachelor of Education degree; and the Appalachian State Teachers' College, which is located in North Carolina.

During her first year at Hialeah, she started the Girl's Athletic League and the following year she began the Girl's Letter Club.

She has been the national secretary of the Phi Delta Pi sorority and is presently the national editor of the sorority's magazine and pamphlet, both of which are nationally circulated.

Miss Swain said of her inclusion in the "Who's Who in American Women," "I was thrilled when I received notification of my selection, and I deem it a great honor to be included in this volume."
